



Dispute Resolution Advisor (DRA)

DRA

First introduced in around 1990 to cater for claims and disputes in hospital construction projects.


To give timely advice on potential problems and facilitate win-win outcomes.

Jointly appointed by the parties from commencement till the end of the project.

Of **59** projects using DRA over the past 5 years, formal Notices of Disputes have arisen in **7** projects, of which, only **1** has ended up in mediation.

Mutual trust and cooperation

Early warning

Pain / gain share

Successfully adopted in \over 400 works contracts and 150 consultancies.



Mediation

In 1999, the "settlement of dispute" provision of the General Conditions was expanded.



Mediation before arbitration or litigation

Rights to proceed to arbitration not affected

Number of arbitration dropped significantly

From 1995 to 2000
6 arbitrations recorded



From 2015 to 2020

1 arbitration recorded, 7 disputes settled through mediation
