

Construction Dispute Resolution Committee 建造事務爭端解決委員會

HKIE Panel of Adjudicators

1. Eligibility for inclusion on the <u>HKIE Panel of Adjudicators</u> shall be determined by the Construction Dispute Resolution Committee (the Committee) based on the following requirements:

The applicant shall:

- be a HKIE Corporate Member; and
- have working experience of at least 10 years in administration, management, supervision of construction contracts in Hong Kong or in dispute resolution relating to construction contracts in Hong Kong; and
- have successfully completed a recognised Adjudication Training Course and passed the written examination, or equivalent.

Note #1: In the event that the applicant has not completed an approved Adjudication Training Course recognized by the Committee, he/she may instead provide supporting evidence on his/her substantial hands-on experience in adjudication/ arbitration/ mediation/ other dispute resolution mechanisms.

(Remarks: Members who have high command of respect in the industry and/or the society and/or with judicial qualities may be invited for inclusion on the Panel. The HKIE reserves the right to ask any potential candidate to be called to an interview to assess his/her suitability for admission to the HKIE Panel of Adjudicators. The decision for admission is at the sole discretion of the Committee and such decision is final, nevertheless, a potential candidate is not barred from re-submitting an application should he/she subsequently satisfy the requirements as stipulated.)

- 2. The Applicant shall confirm that he/she has not been found guilty by a Court or disciplinary tribunal of misconduct, neither been convicted of a criminal offence in accordance with section (2) (1) of the Rehabilitation of Offenders Ordinance, Cap 297 and undertake to inform the Committee if the applicant is charged with a triable criminal offence during the time that being included in the HKIE Panel of Adjudicators.
- 3. By submitting the application and any information to the Committee, the Applicant is deemed to have provided his/her consent to the HKIE to make the information available to the public and third parties for the purposes of listing and referral of adjudicators.
- 4. Copies of the documents relating to the Applicant's education certificates and professional qualifications are required to facilitate the assessment process by the Committee.
- 5. The Committee reserves the right to accept and reject any application without any explanation.
- 6. The decision of the Committee shall be absolutely final on all matters about the assessment or the definitions, interpretations of guidelines of application and disclaimers.
- 7. If, after the application is successful, any information supplied in the respective application is found to be fraudulent or untrue, or an Applicant is found to be associated with a fraudulent or dishonourable act, the Committee reserves the right to withdraw the name of the Applicant from the HKIE Panel of Adjudicators.
- 8. None of the information, details and materials submitted with the application will be returned. The Committee will destroy all such information, details and materials, at its sole discretion.
